

Examples of discontinued uses of the Social Security Number

Office of the Registrar

- Eliminated the SSN from all departmental forms
- Eliminated the SSN from student lists

Institute for Teaching and Learning

- Eliminated from travel reimbursement forms

Orientation Services

- Eliminated SSN from student check-in lists
- Eliminated SSN from lists that go to advisors

UCIMT

- Replaced SSN with PeopleSoft ID on reports

Teaching Assistant Program

- Replaced SSN in Access Data Base with PeopleSoft ID

Travel Services

- Replaced full SSN with last four digits only on the pre-trip Information form, travel authorization, and travel reimbursement forms

Career Services

- Replaced SSN with PeopleSoft ID as the log-in id to the eRecruiting system
- Replaced SSN with the PeopleSoft ID on intake forms

Department of Communication Sciences

- Eliminated SSN from student observation hour forms
- Eliminated SSN from student clock hour forms

School of Business

- Eliminated SSN from all student reports

Graduate School

- Eliminated SSN from all reports

Environmental Health and Safety

- Replaced the SSN with NetID on their data bases

Department of Physics

- Eliminated SSN from student listings

Department of Accounting

- Eliminated the use of student SSN for all but scholarship purposes

UITS

- Eliminated the use of SSN for all NETID and Active Directory processes.

Human Resources

- Removed the SSN from all HR forms except those where the collection of the SSN is required by law or for benefits purposes.

One Card Office

- Removed the SSN from the Husky One Card and various systems that rely on that card.

UCONN Coop

- ❑ Eliminated all references to SSN in member records, member purchase records and POS records for faculty, staff and students.

Alumni Association

- ❑ Eliminated all SSNs in Gift Maker database
